

A QUICK GUIDE FOR BLUE BADGE USERS.

ON STREET PARKING, please refer to signage.

There are a number of designated disabled parking bays as shown on the map (page 2). Please note, some of these are subject to restrictions.

PAY & DISPLAY BAYS: Please refer to your **Blue Badge** Guidance Book.

You may park on a yellow line for up to 3 hours, if there is not a loading ban in force (see below) and the vehicle is not causing an obstruction.

The **Blue Badge** must be clearly displayed with the expiry date face up (Not Your Picture), so that the Civil Enforcement Officers can read the details.

Remember, the **Blue Badge** should only be displayed if the vehicle is being used for the benefit of the holder. Misuse of the badge is a serious offence and may result in a fine of up to £1000.

MUNICIPAL CAR PARKS:

Free parking, for a maximum of 3 hours, for disabled **Blue Badge** holders. **Blue badges** must be clearly displayed in the vehicle and clocks set at the time of arrival on the inside of the windscreen. A valid pay and display ticket must be displayed when parking in any other bay.

BANK STREET CAR PARK.

Due to the surface type in this car park there are no marked out bays. Disabled **Blue Badge** holders can therefore park in any area where it is safe to do so and will not cause an obstruction or inconvenience to others. The 3 hour concession (as described above) is applicable.

CENTRAL BEACH. Although disabled bays are provided the 3 hour concession **DOES NOT** apply. These bays are provided for convenient access purposes only.

TALBOT ROAD MULTI STOREY CAR PARK.

This car park is deemed not suitable for use by disabled drivers, therefore there are no disabled bays.

EXAMPLES OF WHERE YOU MUST NOT PARK:

Where there is a loading ban. These are shown by yellow markings on the kerb and adjacent white time plates.

On the footway.

On pedestrian crossings.

In bays designated for specific users (such as loading bays, taxi bays and bus stops).

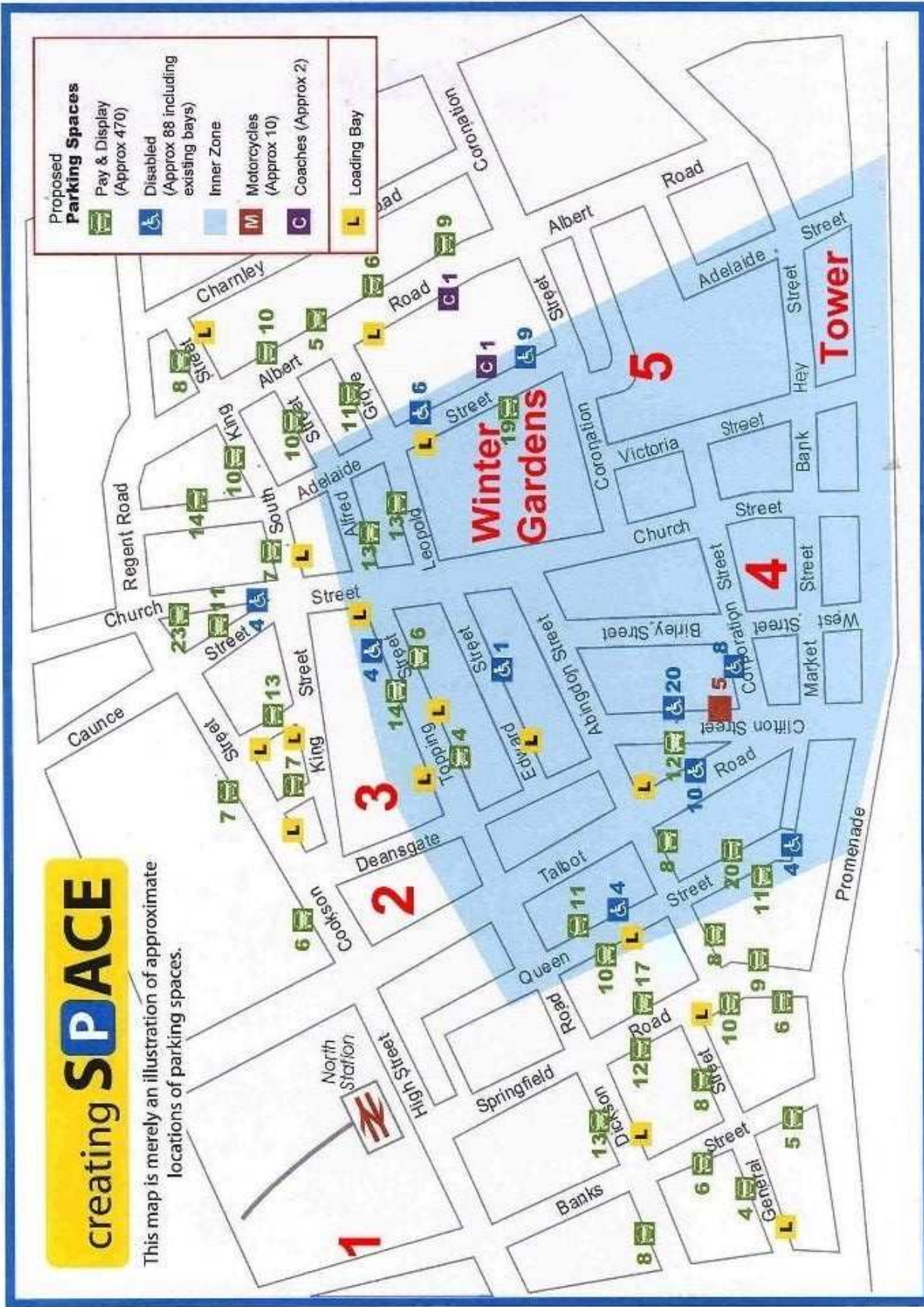
If you cause an obstruction or danger to others, your vehicle may be towed away. Please refer to the information provided with your badge for further details.

- Loading Bay

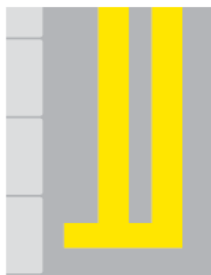

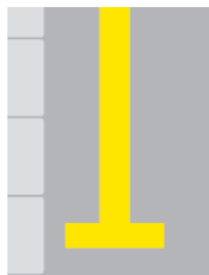
Along the edge of the carriageway

Waiting restrictions

Waiting restrictions indicated by yellow lines apply to the carriageway, pavement and verge. You may stop to load or unload (unless there are also loading restrictions as described below) or while passengers board or alight. Double yellow lines mean no waiting at any time, unless there are signs that specifically indicate seasonal restrictions. The times at which the restrictions apply for other road markings are shown on nearby plates or on entry signs to controlled parking zones. If no days are shown on the signs, the restrictions are in force every day including Sundays and Bank Holidays. White bay markings and upright signs (see below) indicate where parking is allowed.



No waiting at any time

Waiting is limited to the duration specified during the days and times shown

On the kerb or at the edge of the carriageway

Loading restrictions on roads other than Red Routes

Yellow marks on the kerb or at the edge of the carriageway indicate that loading or unloading is prohibited at the times shown on the nearby black and white plates. You may stop while passengers board or alight. If no days are indicated on the signs the restrictions are in force every day including Sundays and Bank Holidays.

ALWAYS CHECK THE TIMES SHOWN ON THE PLATES.

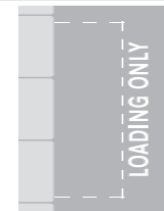
Lengths of road reserved for vehicles loading and unloading are indicated by a white 'bay' marking with the words 'Loading Only' and a sign with the white on blue 'trolley' symbol. This sign also shows whether loading and unloading is restricted to goods vehicles and the times at which the bay can be used. If no times or days are shown it may be used at any time. Vehicles may not park here if they are not loading or unloading.

No loading or unloading at the times shown

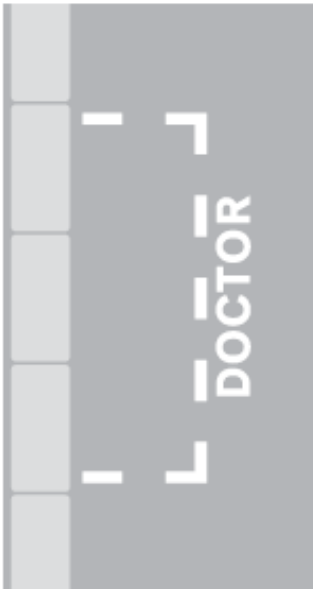


Loading bay

Parking space reserved for vehicles named



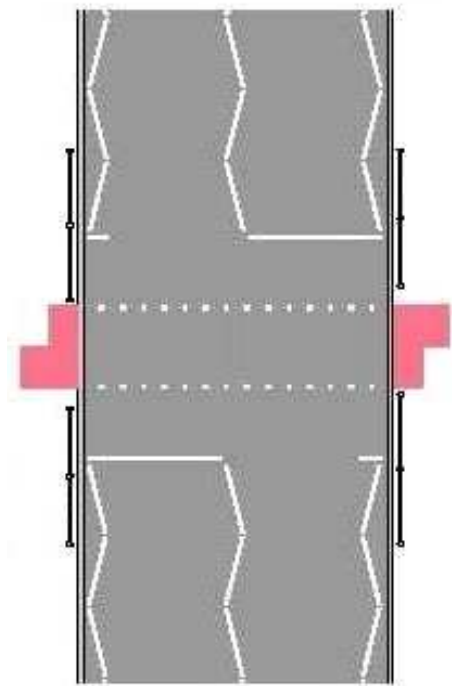
