

## Scrap Metal Dealers

<b>Eligibility criteria</b>	<p>A scrap metal dealer shall be classed as carrying on a business in Blackpool Council's area if any of the following apply:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• the dealer occupies a place as a scrap metal store in the area</li><li>• the dealer does not occupy a place as a scrap metal store but has a usual place of residence in the area</li><li>• the dealer does not occupy a place as a scrap metal store but occupies a place for business purposes</li></ul>

<b>Application Evaluation Process</b>	<p>Applicants must provide the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• their full name</li><li>• the address of the dealer, or in the case of a company, their registered or principal office</li><li>• the address of each place occupied as a scrap metal store, if any</li><li>• if the business is carried on without a scrap metal store</li><li>• if the business is carried on without a scrap metal store but the applicant occupies a place for the purposes of business, and the address of such a place</li></ul> <p>The registered dealer must notify Blackpool Council of any changes to these details or if they cease to be a scrap metal dealer.</p>
<b>Will Tacit Consent Apply?</b>	<p>Yes. This means that you will be able to act as though your application is granted if you have not heard from us by the end of the target completion period.</p>
<b>Failed Application Redress</b>	<p>Please contact Blackpool Council's Licensing Service in the first instance.</p>

<b>Licence Holder Redress</b>	Please contact Blackpool Council's Licensing Service in the first instance.
<b>Consumer Complaint</b>	We would always advise that in the event of a complaint the first contact is made with the trader by you - preferably in the form of a letter (with proof of delivery).
