

Motorcycle Bays
Provided By Blackpool Council
Parking Services



Motorcycle bays are available on most Blackpool Council owned car parks. Motorcycles may use these bays free of charge. Please do not occupy a Disabled Person's bay (outlined in yellow). If you choose to park in any other marked bay you will need to buy a Pay and Display ticket. Do not leave this ticket on the motorcycle, take it with you, we will need to see it if you get issued with a Penalty Charge Notice. Park legally and enjoy your visit.

South Beach. FY4 1BB

This car park is divided into two sections (North and South). The motorcycle bay is in the northern end directly opposite the crossing leading to the Pleasure Beach.

East Topping Street. FY1 3AS

Motorcycle bay is located in the northwest corner at the junction with East Topping Street and Deansgate

Central Car Park. FY1 5QE

The motorcycle bay is currently situated at the rear of the car park facing Blackpool Police Office and court building.

Gynn Square. FY1 2JR

This is a shared parking space. Cars use the area beyond the height barrier. Coaches use the remaining area. The motorcycle bay is on the left of the entrance.

Rigby Road. FY1 5DR*

Motorcycle bay situated along the left side-wall towards the rear of the car park. Ideal for Blackpool Football Club.

Motorcycle bays are also available on the following car parks:

West Street. FY1 1HA (First floor)

Lytham Road. FY4 1HT*

Blundell Street. FY1 5DB

Chapel Street. FY1 5AW (Ground floor under the stairs)

Banks Street. FY1 2DJ (Loose surface, no marked bays)

There is also a motorcycle bay at the Abingdon St end of **Clifton Street FY1 1LY** in the town centre for short stay purposes (60 minute stay, no return within one hour). Do not use the bicycle bay at the other end of the street.

PLEASE NOTE Some car parks (marked *) do not currently have a postcode assigned to them so they have been given the "Nearest Available" code rather than no code at all.

Remember, if you occupy a Pay and Display bay (Car Parks or On-Street) you must purchase a ticket. Keep the ticket with you, do not leave on the vehicle. This applies to 2 wheeled and 3 wheeled vehicles (Motorbike and Sidecar). If you receive a Penalty Charge Notice we will need to see a copy of your Pay & Display ticket.
