### Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004 (19).

#### Extending Your Home - Supplementary Planning Document

Blackpool Council, Fylde and Wyre Borough Councils have jointly produced a House Extensions Supplementary Planning Document (SPD).

Blackpool Council adopted the Supplementary Planning Document on **28<sup>th</sup> November 2007**. The SPD supplements policies BH3, LQ1, LQ2, LQ6, LQ8, LQ9, LQ10, LQ14, NE3 and NE7 contained within the adopted Blackpool Local Plan 2001-2016.

The SPD forms part of the Development Plan for Blackpool and will be used to inform decisions on land use planning affecting the area. The SPD is available for inspection at the following addresses:-

The proposals came into operation on 28<sup>th</sup> November 2007. Any person aggrieved by the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the SPD. Such an application must be made promptly and in any event not later than three months after the date on which the SPD was adopted (28<sup>th</sup> November 2007).
