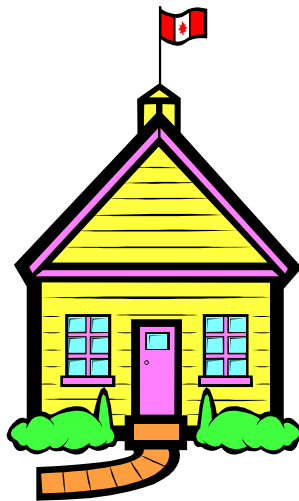

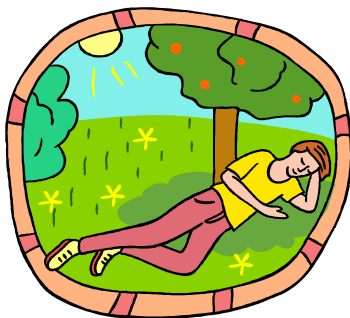




Our House

And a garden where you may want to spend quiet time



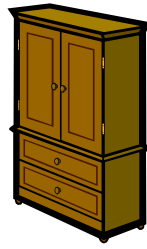


This is the dining room

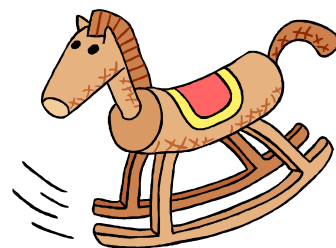
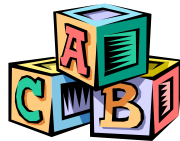


This is the lounge, where you

You will have help to bath, shower or wash

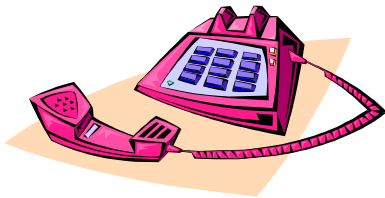


Your foster carers will help you with things you want to do.



You will still go to school and your foster carers will help you with homework or any special projects.

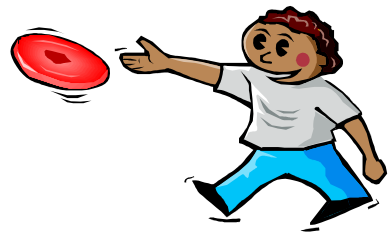

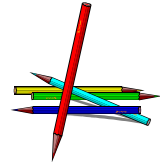
