1.0 Introduction

- 1.0 This document accompanies and updates the Statement of Compliance on the Submitted Draft of the Statement of Community Involvement produced in October 2006.
- 1.1 Following pre-draft consultation, a draft version of the Statement of Community Involvement was produced. This document went out for a six week period of statutory public consultation between 24th. June and 5th. August 2005. Fifteen representations were received on this document. These comments were considered and a Submission Draft of the Statement of Community Involvement was produced and submitted to the Secretary of State on 16th. October, 2006.
- 1.2 A six week period of statutory public consultation was undertaken on the Submitted Draft of the Statement of Community Involvement between 20th. October and 1st. December, 2006. A total of 57 representations were received from 18 respondents.
- 1.3 This document is the Submission Consultation Statement required under Regulation 31 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004.

2.0 Blackpool Council Submission Consultation Statement (Regulation 31 statement)

- 2.1 Following pre-draft consultation, the preparation of a draft Statement of Community Involvement and consultation on this document, a final version was submitted to the Secretary of State on 16th. October, 2006. Consultation was then undertaken on the Submission Draft of the Statement of Community Involvement for a six week period from 20th. October to 1st. December, 2006.
