Guidance Notes

1. Please write the name by which the premises is commonly known.
2. Please identify the person or company, responsible for compliance with the conditions attached to the Petroleum Spirit Licence. Where the premises is occupied by a corporation identified as a public limited company or as a limited company, the licensee is the corporation and the address is the registered office of that company. If any person to whom a petroleum spirit licence is granted contravenes any condition of the licence, they shall be guilty of an offence as per Section 1(3) Petroleum (Consolidation) Act 1928.
3. The Licence or a copy of the licence must be kept on the licensed premises.
4. This should be the same amount as indicated on the previous licence. Where there has been a change, this **MUST BE INDICATED** and further details record in section 7. Do not include any other products stored in the vicinity, such as diesel.
5. Please indicate for above ground storage whether static or mobile or both types of storage are used.
6. The purpose for which petroleum is used:
 - a) 'Retail Petroleum Filling Station' means the premises used, or intended for use, for dispensing petroleum-spirit to the public for use in motor vehicles, ships or aircraft by way of sale.
 - b) 'Non-Retail Petroleum Filling Station' means premises used, or intended for use, for dispensing petroleum-spirit for use in motor vehicles, ships, but does not include any retail petroleum filling station.
 - c) 'Private use' means the storage and use at a place or site where no person is employed to work.
7. It is a contravention of the conditions attached to the petroleum spirit licence to make any alteration to the licensed premises that affect the approved arrangements (including the demolition of any tank on site) unless written consent has been given by the Licensing Authority.
8. The 'model conditions' that will be attached to the petroleum licence when and if it is granted are available on request from the Licensing Office.

Fee Payable:

Scale of fees payable annually to the Licensing Authority by the person whom a licence has been granted to keep petroleum spirit or carbide of calcium as fixed by the Health and Safety (Explosives and Petroleum Fees) Regulations 1987, in respect of a licence to keep a quantity of:

Up to but not exceeding 2500 litres (500 gallons) of petroleum or 2500 kilos of carbide of calcium is **£42** including VAT.

Exceeding 2500 litres or 2500 kilos but not exceeding 50,000 litres or 50,000 kilos is **£58** including VAT.

Exceeding 50,000 litres or 50,000 kilos is **£120** including VAT.
