

## Performing Animals Registration

<b>Eligibility criteria</b>	There is no specific criteria to satisfy. Blackpool Council is required to register anyone who applies.
<b>Relevant Legislation</b>	Performing Animals Act 1925 <a href="#">Performing Animals Act - OPSI website</a>
<b>Application Evaluation Process</b>	Pay the required fee (£50 for new applications / £30 for a variation to a registration) and complete the application form, then registration will be complete.
<b>Will Tacit Consent Apply?</b>	Yes. This means that you will be able to act as though your application is granted if you have not heard from us by the end of the target completion period.
<b>Failed Application Redress</b>	Please contact Blackpool Council's Licensing Service in the first instance.
<b>Licence Holder Redress</b>	Please contact Blackpool Council's Licensing Service in the first instance.
<b>Consumer Complaint</b>	We would always advise that in the event of a complaint the first contact is made with the trader by you - preferably in the form of a letter (with proof of delivery). <b>Other Redress</b>	A police officer or authorised officer of the Council may make a complaint to the local magistrates' court if they feel that animals have been subject to cruelty.
