The Two Versions Of The Register

The electoral registration officer makes and keeps two versions of the electoral register - the full register and the edited register. Please say in your application if you wish your name and address to be excluded from the edited register.

The Full Register

The full register lists everyone who is entitled to vote. You can check it by calling at the council offices or at some local libraries. Only certain people and organisations can have copies of the full register, and they can only use it for specified purposes. These include electoral purposes, the prevention and detection of crime and checking your identity when you have applied for credit. The law says who can have a copy of the full register and what they can use it for. The full list of such persons and purposes is given in the Representation of the People (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 2002. It is a criminal offence for them to pass it on to anyone else or to use it for any other purposes.

The Edited Register

The edited register leaves out the names and addresses of people who have asked for them to be excluded from that version of the register. The edited register can be bought by anyone who asks for a copy and they may use it for any purpose.

Anonymous Registration

If your (or someone in your household's) safety would be at risk if your name and address was on the electoral register, you may be able to register anonymously. Please telephone 477490 or 477161 for more details.

Please note: Opting out of the edited register will not exclude your details from being sent to the Credit Agencies. Please note also that this Authority is under a duty to protect the public funds it administers, and to this end may use the information you have provided for the prevention and detection of fraud. It may also share this information with other bodies responsible for auditing and administering public funds for these purposes.

Do the names of all the occupiers who are eligible to vote appear above?

Has each occupier signed the form? We cannot include names on the register of electors without signatures.
