Crisis and Resilience Fund Housing Payment and Council Tax Reduction Discretionary Discount

If the amount of Housing Benefit or the housing costs element of Universal Credit you receive does not cover your full rent, you may be able to apply for a Crisis and Resilience Fund Housing Payment (CRFHP) to help you pay the shortfall.

A CRF housing payment may also be able to help if you have an **urgent** need to move with no time to save for a bond for a private sector tenancy. You must be in receipt of Housing Benefit or Universal Credit Housing Costs in order to be considered for a CRFHP. Please note that awards are not guaranteed and each application is considered on its own merits.

If you need extra help towards your Council Tax you may qualify for a Council Tax Reduction Discretionary Discount.

You will need to complete an online application form and we will look at your personal and financial circumstances. For example:

- Your income
- Whether you have any savings
- Whether anyone else in the house is able to help you pay your rent
- Whether you have any loans or debts still to pay
- Whether you could manage your money better to ease the situation
- Whether you or your family are ill or disabled

Once you have submitted your application you will need to send us an up-to-date rent statement and your last 2 months bank statements.
