We can continue to offer to support to care leavers aged over 21 years until they turn 25.

You can step back from service and step back in to services as often as you need.

The support we will provide includes:

- Access to our care leaver app 'The Core' which includes lots of useful information including employment opportunities, traineeships, apprenticeships and a tools to support you with budgeting
- A free and confidential advice service available 24/7 via our Wisdom App and free phone number
- If you go to university and will not be finishing your course until you are over 25 we can keep working with you after you turn 25 if you would like us to
- Access to the university bursary and all other aspects of a university package including financial assistance and general support
- Passport to Leisure until 25 or a gym membership wherever you live in the country
- Support in accessing medical appointments including access to a dentist and free prescriptions - Our young people can also access free prescriptions (either with support to [apply for exception](#) or we will pay for an [prepayment cert](#)).
- Access to your leaving care grant if you haven't accessed it before the age of 25
- Leaving care dvisor and Pathway Plan: If you want this, we will agree with you how often we see you and what we will help you with
