Cosy Homes in Lancashire

Blackpool Council is working with local authorities in Lancashire to help households access funding for energy-related improvements to their homes.

If your property is suitable, you may be entitled to free energy efficiency improvements, including air source heat pumps, solar panels, battery storage, and insulation measures.

Warm Homes local grant

The government's Warm Homes: Local Grant is now available to Blackpool residents.

This means that you could make improvements to your home, with zero cost to you, as Cosy Homes in Lancashire will pick up the bill to help you be warmer and more comfortable at home.

If you and your property are eligible, the following energy efficient measures may be covered by the grant:

- Insulation (solid wall insulation, loft/cavity, room in roof and underfloor)
- Renewable heating technologies
- Energy efficient external doors and window upgrades (subject to recommendation from a retrofit assessor)Solar PV

You may be eligible if:

- Your property has a low Energy Performance Certificate (EPC) rating of band D, E, F or G
- You own the home (including private landlords and park homes on residential sites)
- Are a private tenant
- You are in receipt of any benefits **or**
- The occupants of the home have a combined gross annual household income of less than £36,000 per year **or**
- Your property is in an [eligible postcode area](#)
