- If you find a stray dog and you know the owner, please return it to them as soon as possible.
- If you find a stray dog and do not know the owner and you feel able to do so, please take dog in and arrange for us to come and collect it.
- If you do not feel comfortable taking in the dog please report it to us as soon as possible.

Our dog wardens will attempt to return the dog to its owner (if known) or if they can't they will put it into kennels.

Dogs put into kennels must be claimed within 7 days.
