Surveys also provide valuable data about how local services are seen to change over time, including people's preferences and expectations.

## Engagement

### St John's Square

Following extensive engagement with the local community from June 2023 until December 2023, we have reviewed the feedback which showed a relatively high percentage of respondents would feel safer if this area was closed to all traffic, including taxis and buses.

The consultation period will now be extended to carry out further engagement, with particular focus on whether St John’s Square and the surrounding area should be closed to all traffic outside of servicing hours.
