Blackpool town centre BID

The BID (Business Improvement District) is a partnership between more than 800 of Blackpool's town centre businesses and organisations. Together, they are working to improve business and the environment for the benefit of all.

The BID is funded in whole or in part by a levy, additional to the non-domestic rates, and the amount payable is a percentage of the rateable value of a property in the rating list.

In August 2015, the BID successfully re-balloted its members and received approval for another 5 year period. The percentage levy throughout the lifetime of this second BID will remain at 1%.

The main goal of BID is to work in partnership with Blackpool Council and all local organisations; co-ordinating new and existing projects to deliver solutions that are right for Blackpool's town centre businesses.
