# Petroleum storage

You will require a certificate from the council if you store petroleum to be used for any of the following purposes:

- In a retail petroleum filling station, for dispensing to the public for use in motor vehicles, ships or aircraft by way of sale
- In a non-retail petroleum filling station, for use in motor vehicles, ships, but not including any retail petroleum filling station
- For private use, at a place or site where no person is employed to work

The <u>Petroleum (Consolidation) Regulations 2014 (PCR)</u> came into force on 1 October 2014 which replace all previous legislation on petroleum storage.

Further information is available from the <u>Health and Safety Executive</u>.

### Apply for a Petroleum Storage Certificate

You can apply for a petroleum storage certificate by completing and returning the <u>application form</u> together with the fee as stated on the form. Fees are based upon the quantity of petroleum to be stored.

The premises will be inspected by a health and safety officer prior to the certificate being issued.

#### Tacit consent

Tacit consent **does not** apply. It is in the public interest that Blackpool Council must process your application before it can be granted. If you have not heard from us within a reasonable period, please <u>contact us</u>.

### Failed application redress/Licence holder redress

Please contact Blackpool Council Licensing Service in the first instance. If an application is refused the applicant may appeal to the secretary of state.

### Complaints

- Consumer complaint: We would always advise that in the event of a complaint the first contact is made with the trader by you preferably in the form of a letter (with proof of delivery). If that has not worked, if you are located in the UK, <u>Citizens Advice</u>
   <u>Consumer Service</u> can give you advice. From outside the UK contact the <u>European Consumer Centre for Services</u>
- Other redress: Complaints about the operation of the premises should be directed to Blackpool Council Licensing Service
