

## Hypnotism Authorisation

<b>Eligibility criteria</b>	The application must be submitted not less than 28 days in advance of the performance concerned.
<b>Relevant legislation</b>	Hypnotism Act 1952 <a href="#">Hypnotism Act 1952 - OPSI website</a>
<b>Application Evaluation Process</b>	An application fee of £41.00 is payable.  Whilst each application will be determined on its own merits, applications that cause concern will be referred to the Public Protection Sub-Committee for consideration.  Conditions will apply to any consent given.
<b>Will Tacit Consent Apply?</b>	Yes. This means that you will be able to act as though your application is granted if you have not heard from us by the end of the target completion period.
<b>Failed Application Redress</b>	Please contact Blackpool Council's Licensing Service in the first instance.
<b>Licence Holder Redress</b>	Please contact Blackpool Council's Licensing Service in the first instance.
<b>Consumer Complaint</b>	We would always advise that in the event of a complaint the first contact is made with the trader by you - preferably in the form of a letter (with proof of delivery).
