An existing gambling premises licence can be varied to add, amend or remove conditions or hours permitted by the licence.

A licence can also be varied to amend another detail of the licence such as the layout of the premises.

There is a **28 day consultation period** when you apply to vary a premises licence. If no objections are received at the end of this period the application will be granted and we then aim to issue your licence within 10 working days.

Apply to vary your premises licence

As with applications for a new licence, you need to advertise your application and notify the responsible authorities - please read the [guidance notes](#) [PDF 67KB] for further details.

The application will be granted after 28 days if no representations are received. If representations are received a committee hearing can be held to determine the application, assuming outstanding issues cannot be resolved.
