- Subject to permission being granted ask you to agree to the standard terms and conditions.
- In the case of larger and commercial events may issue a bespoke license

It is important that the person with overall responsibility for the event completes the online form and provides the below information as soon as possible after your provisional booking has been accepted. The application should ideally be made at least 12 weeks in advance of your event taking place.

- Public liability event insurance
- Your completed notification form will be automatically forwarded to the tramway safety officer who may contact you if he considers that your event requires you to apply for a tramway safety permit
