

The 4 steps to assessing risk in the workplace

1. Look for hazards
2. Evaluate the risks, deciding whether the existing precautions are adequate or should be amended
3. Record your findings and keep on file
4. Review your assessment periodically and revise when necessary

In the case of compulsory school age employees, particular attention must be paid to the young person's lack of experience, training and supervision needs in the workplace.

You are required to notify their parents or legal guardians that a risk assessment has taken place and share your findings with them.
