Wanting to transfer your child to another Blackpool school?

Secondary school

If your child attends a Blackpool secondary school and you are thinking of transferring him or her to another Blackpool secondary school, you should make an appointment with their current school to discuss your reasons for wanting a move. An application form will be available from the school.

Primary school

If your child attends a Blackpool primary school and you wish to transfer him or her to another Blackpool primary school, you must complete the primary in-year application form. You can download the form, which will need to be printed.
