The voluntary code of conduct means that all the companies who have signed up, have agreed not to carry out practices that are frowned upon, like doorstep selling. It also ensures they will comply with planning regulations, avoiding headaches for residents, and takes into account building heritage issues. This is particularly important if your property needs external wall insulation.

In addition, Blackpool residents could save on their energy bills and further protect themselves against rogue traders, thanks to a new deal between Blackpool Council and the private sector. Blackpool Council has joined the other Lancashire councils in the [Cosy Homes in Lancashire](#) scheme, also known as [CHiL](#) for short. The scheme aims to help residents access free loft and cavity wall insulation, and replacement boilers (free subject to qualifying criteria). The scheme uses approved installers across Lancashire who will have clear visible [CHiL](#) branded identification.
