## Promenades

Blackpool welcomes responsible dog owners. Please help us to keep the seafront a safe and clean place for all residents and visitors.

Dogs must be kept on a lead on the promenade at all times between **North and South Piers** and any area specified where there is no physical barrier between the highway and or tram track and the promenade.

## Beaches

Blackpool is proud of its award winning clean beaches and happy to welcome dogs and their responsible owners. There is however an exclusion period.

Between **1 May and 30 September** dogs are not allowed to be exercised on the beach at all between **North Pier** and the **Mirror Ball** opposite the Solaris Centre.

These restrictions do not apply to guide dogs, they are allowed at all times throughout the year.

### Beaches where dogs are welcome at all times throughout the year

Beaches where dogs are welcome are from

- The Solaris, Mirror Ball to Squires Gate (South)
- North Pier – Anchorholme (North)

We do advise that dogs are exercised on lead and or owners have full control using reliable recall, if unleashed.
