Pest control

Blackpool Council provides a pest control service for domestic properties and commercial customers.

Domestic pest control

Type of pest	Charge
Rodents (rats and mice)	£90 up to 3 visits by the pest controller for a 3 bedroom house, advice to prevent future infestations. An additional £10 per bedroom will be charged for larger properties.
Insects (ants and fleas)	£67 to cover a one-off for a 3 bedroom house visit and the cost of insecticides used. Please note: we do not treat woodworm beetles or bedbugs. An additional £7.50 per bedroom will be charged for larger properties.
Bees and wasps	£57.50

All our staff have been risk assessed to enter properties. However, if you or a member of your household has had or currently has symptoms of COVID-19 we will not attend. Also if anyone is isolating we are unable to attend.

Customers will be required to maintain social distancing of minimum 1 m away from our staff whilst they are in your premises.

On arrival if the pest control officer decides he doesn't need to carry out a treatment and only needs to offer advice, then we will charge £20.

We will then refund the rest of the fee you paid

A £10 discount is available to pensioners and people of certain benefits.

Please note: All treatments are carried out on a pre-pay basis only
