### Yes please

- Cans
- Food tins (bean tins, biscuit tins)
- Aluminium foil
- Foil trays
- Aerosols including deodorant cans and air fresheners
- Glass bottles of any colour
- Glass jars of any colour
- Plastic bottles
- Solid lids on pots tubs and trays
- Pots (yogurt, soup)
- Tubs (margarine, ice cream)
- Trays/punnets (raw meat or ham trays, take-away trays, fruit /veg trays) - **please remove remove any plastic film**
- Chocolate and biscuit tubs and trays
- Plant pots - **please remove plants and soil**

### No thanks

- Broken glass
- Window glass
- Polystyrene
- Plastic toys
- Any other plastic

Extra recycling waste will be taken if left in an open bag next to your recycling bin or sack.
