# Lancashire local flood risk management strategy 2021 to 2027

#### Introduction

The Flood and Water Management Act 2010 designated Blackburn-with-Darwen Council, Blackpool Council and Lancashire County Council as lead local flood authorities (LLFAs).

The councils have a range of powers, duties and responsibilities and are responsible for managing flood risk from 'local' sources. These local sources of flooding are surface water, groundwater and ordinary watercourses.

## Local flood risk management strategy

Under Section 9 of the Flood and Water Management Act 2010, lead local flood authorities must produce a local flood risk management strategy which is consistent with the national flood and coastal erosion risk management strategy.

Lancashire's lead local flood authorities have produced a joint strategy which sets out:

- Context about the ways in which we manage flood risk
- Local flood risks, challenges and opportunities for Lancashire
- Our vision for how we can address these risks and challenges, and how we will make the most of opportunities
- Our business plan, setting out how and when measures will be implemented to achieve this
- How we will monitor and review delivery of our strategy

### Strategy approval and annual update

Cabinet approvals were secured from Lancashire County Council (4 November 2021), Blackpool Council (11 October 2021) and Blackburn-with-Darwen Council (8 November 2021) through October and November 2021, with the last approval being granted on 8 November 2021. The stratagey includes a commitment to produce an annual monitoring report, which highlights the progress that has been made on the delivery of the agreed objectives.
