

## **New Homes from Old Places Residential Conversion and Sub-Division Supplementary Planning Document (SPD)**

### **Adoption Statement**

The New Homes from Old Places Residential Conversion and Sub-Division Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) was adopted by Blackpool Council on **23<sup>rd</sup> March 2011**. The SPD provides design guidance on the conversion or sub-division of properties for residential use, and supersedes SPG 10 'Change of Use of Holiday Accommodation and Conversion of Properties to Permanent Residential Use and Holiday Flats' (1999).

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than three months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
